WHAT IS THE COMMUNITY STRATEGIC PLAN?

The Community Strategic Plan is the highest level of strategic document of Council, identifying the community's priorities that guide Council's direction over 10 years.

It identifies the themes and broad adjectives relating to key issues facing the Gunnedah Community.

WHY HAVE A COMMUNITY STRATEGIC PLAN?

The NSW Government requires all NSW councils to produce an Integrated Planning and Reporting Framework to ensure Local Government operations and strategic plans are meeting the needs of the community.



The Community Strategic Plan will provide an overall 10-year vision for this framework. This time around, we're just doing a 'pulse check' to see if we're on the right track.

Once we've collated responses from the whole community, Council will take all feedback into consideration and apply a balanced approach to prioritising the aspirations of the Gunnedah Shire Community.
