# The Competition

The GYC Drought Relief Short Film Competition is a chance for young people to unleash their creativity and experience living in the country for a good cause!

**COMPETITION OPENS**  
9.00am Monday, 11 February 2019

**COMPETITION CLOSES**  
5.00pm Friday, 29 March 2019

It costs just \$10.00 per entry, with the winner being awarded a \$200 'Why Leave Town' Gunnedah voucher for their efforts!

All competition entrants must submit a short film that meets the following requirements:

**Theme:** 'Life in the country'

**Featured line of dialogue:** "Rain? What rain?"

**Featured prop:** Akubra (or similar country style) hat

**Duration:** 10 minutes maximum run time

**Rating:** Films are to be no higher than PG rated

Any entry received after the expiry of the Competition period will be deemed invalid. Entrants may use a filming device of their choice, and all footage used in the film must be original and carried out by participants only.

Once your short film has been reviewed and shortlisted, participants under the age of 18 will be required to have a permission note signed for their film to be screened publically.

# The Showcase

The GYC Drought Relief Showcase is an opportunity to get a glimpse into country life from young people's perspective! There will be finger food served at the start of the night and all shortlisted entries from the GYC Drought Relief Short Film Competition will have their film shown on the big screen as part of the Showcase. Entry is free for shortlisted entrants and they will be presented with a certificate on the night for their portfolios.
