

5.5 Compliance and enforcement

- (a) NSW Health is responsible for the administration and enforcement of the *Smoke-free Environment Act 2000* and penalties for non-compliance may be issued by those persons authorised to do so under the said Act.
- (b) Enforcement of this Policy will be supported primarily through smoke-free zone signage, community education, positive persuasion and self-policing amongst the community. Enforcement may also involve the issuing of penalty infringement notices by Council's Authorised Officers where required, as an additional measure to achieve compliance.
