## **INTRODUCTION**

Plans and specifications of your proposal need to be provided to help the certifying authority determine whether it complies with set standards and requirements.

		Site Plan  (Must include location and measurements of the boundaries of the land, distances of development from all lot boundaries, location and use of existing buildings and existing vegetation, location of buildings on adjoining allotments, North arrow, existing ground levels and must be drawn to a scale)  Where relevant:  Parking arrangements, how vehicles will move about the site, including entry/exit points,  Proposed landscaping, types of vegetation to be used (including their height and maturity), how you intend to drain the land.	
		Floor Plan (Must include existing building layout and building dimensions for additions and alterations to be conducted)	
		Elevations (Must include height of the building, all external finishes and finished ground level and should include the existing building for any additions and alterations) Section Plans	
		(Showing a through image of the development from the footings to the top of the proposed works and details of fire safety and resistance measures for their full extent)	
	Category 1 Fire Safety Provisions (Change of use only, must include provision for existing and proposed building use)
