Why is it important to collect green waste?

The collection of green waste has been identified as an enormous opportunity for resource recovery and reducing the amount of waste sent to landfills, as it accounts for a large percentage of household rubbish. Further, green waste and other organics break down anaerobically (without oxygen) in landfills, producing methane, a harmful greenhouse gas twenty times more potent that carbon dioxide.
