

Advisory Council

The Gunnedah Sports Advisory Council is a Committee of Gunnedah Shire Council, formally adopted by Council at its February 2005 Meeting. Meetings are held bi-monthly.

The purpose of the Committee is to make recommendations to Council regarding the following issues:

- (i) Identification, prioritisation and funding options for enhancement of current and future sporting facilities in the Gunnedah Shire Local Government Area. More specifically to:
 - a) To make recommendations to Council with respect to its Capital Works Program for consideration in the Management Plan deliberation process. Deadline 28 February each year.
 - b) To undertake prioritisation of applications submitted to the Department of Sport and Recreation under the Capital Assistance Grants Program.
 - c) To undertake prioritisation of applications submitted to the Department of Sport and Recreation under the Regional Sports Facility Grants Program.
 - d) Submission of other grant/subsidy applications in relation to sporting infrastructure and programs.

- (ii) Other Sporting Related Issues:
 - a) To explore opportunities and make recommendations to Council regarding cooperative use of sporting facilities.
 - b) To recommend to Council a sporting events calendar.
 - c) To facilitate and support where practical and feasible cooperative sporting related events.

The Committee comprises 2 Councillors, a Council officer and elected representatives from the Local Sporting Community.
